Can they identify one more or less than a given number?

Can they count in twos forward and backward to 20?

Can they use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10?

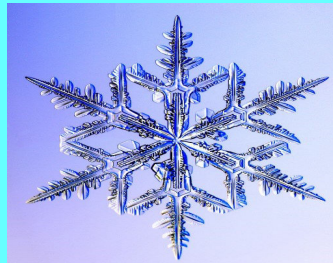
Can they find half and a quarter of a shape/amount?
