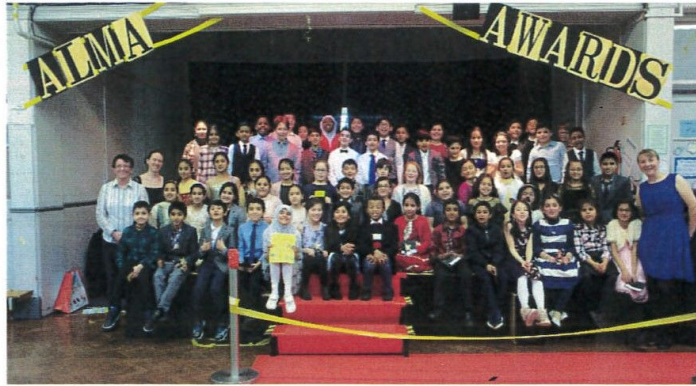


ALMA GOES BOOM!
